Raymond C. Wifler Music Scholarship

The Raymond C. Wifler Music Scholarship was established by the Fond du Lac Symphonic Band to honor Dr. Raymond C. Wifler and to enable deserving music students to receive private instruction on their instrument. Dr. Wifler served the Fond du Lac community for 43 years as music director of the Fond du Lac Symphonic Band. This scholarship is intended to honor his legacy and encourage musical excellence among young musicians who are involved in school and community bands.

SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Two \$250 semester scholarships will be awarded on an annual basis. Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- is a student who is currently in Grades 9-12 or the first year of college (grade 13).
- attends any school in Fond du Lac County or the Lomira School District
- plays an instrument that is used in a concert band or jazz ensemble
- is a member of their school concert band and/or jazz ensemble, or an adult instrumental group such as the Fond du Lac Symphonic Band, completes the application, which includes a personal statement and a recommendation from their school band director. **Please Note:** Band Director Recommendations are to be sent directly to the Fond du Lac Area Foundation by the Band Director. They are not to be sent in by the applicant.
- application and director recommendation forms are due by March 15.
- performs an audition to be scheduled and performed by June 1
- Activities listed on the next page of the application, such as INSTRUMENTAL INVOLEMENT, MUSIC AWARDS AND COMMUNITY MUSIC INVOLVEMENT will be given consideration but will not necessarily be the determining factor in deciding the scholarship winner.

- Upon selection, a private instructor will be reviewed and approved by the scholarship committee. If needed, a recommendation will be made. The instructor will be paid directly from the Fond du Lac Symphonic Band.
- Students may apply to receive this scholarship more than once, as long as they continue to meet the criteria. A second audition may not be required.
- Students must have their school band director fill out the following recommendation and submit it by March 15.
