

Johanna Schultz Memorial Scholarship Application



This scholarship was established in 2024 to memorialize a Laconia High School alumna and Marian University student who tragically lost her life in March of 2023. Johanna Schultz was a bright young woman who loved her family and worked hard while pursuing a double major at Marian. This fund was established with the generous help of other Fond du Lac Area Foundation fundholders who were touched by Johanna's story, and the Schultz family seeks to keep her memory alive with this scholarship dedicated for other Laconia High and Marian students.

One \$1,000 award is available. Students will be reviewed based on financial need as well as the following requirements.

APPLICANTS MUST:

- Be graduating high school seniors or current undergraduate students
- Be graduating or have graduated from Laconia High School
- Attend or plan to attend Marian University of Wisconsin on a full-time basis
- Hold a 3.25 minimum cumulative GPA
- Have some extracurricular, volunteer, and/or employment experience; involvement with their churches may qualify as volunteer experience/community service
